We are Scientists:

Unit 1

How does light help us see?

We will conduct a series of experiments to explore how light helps us see and how it can be affected. We will use a variety of subordinating conjunctions to explain our observations and findings.

Unit 2

Why do people settle in different places?

In our geography unit we will explore what the main features of Sutton Benger are and explore reasons why somebody would choose to live there. We will think about land use and our writing linked to this unit will be a postcard.

We are Historians:

Unit 3

Who were the Mayans and what did they teach us?

We will be learning about Ancient Mayans all the amazing things they did. The children will learn about their homes, pyramids, farming, games, food, belief and much more! They will create a leaflet explaining everything. Everyone will be focusing on commas in lists and Y3s will also use apostrophes.

We are Philosophers, Theologians and Sociologists:

Unit 4

Who is a Muslim and what do they believe?

This unit enables pupils to learn in depth from Islam, finding out about Muslim ways of life and beliefs, so that pupils can develop thoughtful ideas and viewpoints of their own about some religious and spiritual questions.

Maths

Year 2 will revisit their addition and subtraction unit to consolidate their learning and then will move on to length and perimeter of shapes and mass, capacity and temperature.

Our year 3 mathematicians will continue our multiplication and division and then will learn how to multiply a 2 digit and 1 digit number. We will then be learning about measuring in millimetres and centimetres and finding the perimeter of shapes.
