We are Geographers:

Unit 1

What can we find out about Sutton Benger and our local area?

-Beech class will be studying human and physical features of our local area and will use Digimaps (an online Geography resource) to identify these.

-Beech class will also study compass directions and grid references. We even have a trip planned to Malmesbury as part of our unit learning, to compare facilities in a town with those in a village!

We are Historians:

Unit 2

What can we find out about the history of our local area?

-Beech class will be finding out about the history of our local area. We will visit the Anglo-Saxon town of Malmesbury and discover the importance of this hill-top town. We will be reading to learn about local characters: Eilmer the flying monk and Hannah Twynnoy and use our knowledge to write a report.

Unit 3

What can we find out about Peru and South America?

-Beech class will study a contrasting locality and identify similarities and differences between the local area and Lima in Peru!

-We will be making very exciting links to Paddington bear and will be writing postcards and letters, as well as producing a leaflet about Peru!
