We are Geographers:

Unit 1

What is the water cycle?

As geographers, we will be learning about the water cycle. We will be carrying out experiments to learn about the stages that water goes on. Our writing will be an information text with Y2 focusing on sequencing their sentences correctly and Y3 using paragraphs.

Unit 2

Year 2 - How do authors use apostrophes in their writing?

We will be focusing on an adventure book and will write our own sequel. Year 2 will be using apostrophes for singular possession and contractions and Year 3 will be using speech marks.

We will be creating many different pieces of artwork using ink, inspired by different artists.

Why do people pray?

We will be learning about the importance of praying in different cultures. We will be using a range of conjunctions to explain.

Year 2 - Maths

Year 2 will be learning about fractions. They will find equal parts, a half, a quarter, a third and a whole of amounts.

They will also learn about time, focusing on quarter past, quarter to, half past and o'clock.

Year 3 - Maths

Year 3 will recap fractions and then learn to add and subtract fractions.

We will go on to add and subtract money and find change.

Then, we will cover time and be able to tell the time to the minute and read a 12 and 24 hour clock.
