## We are Authors:

How do authors write alternative 1 versions of a well-known story?

We will be reading the story of Little Red and the Very Hungry Lion.' We will look at how the story is different to the original and use this as a basis to change it again to write our own version. We will be using all of the writing skills we have learnt this year including super sentences, using conjunctions, adjectives and expanded noun phrases.





What are plants and what are their

We will be identifying and naming different garden and wild plants and trees. We will then be looking at the structure of plants and trees and writing reports on what we find out. We will undertake some exciting experiments too, using what we have learnt!
