

# Oak Curriculum - Term 3

## How did life change for the Victorians under Victoria's reign? **Unit 1**

Y6 will discover more about Queen Victoria, how life changed for Victorians during her reign (particularly the lives of children), what the education system was like and how society looked by the end of her reign. We will read extracts from the book Street Child to support our writing as a poor Victorian child.

## We are Designers: **Unit 2** How can we fix a hole in textiles?

In our Victorian unit, we will learn that sewing was something that was taught in schools. We will also be learning how to sew using different stitches and even fixing some items of clothing that have holes in! We may even try sewing particular designs!

## We are Scientists: **Unit 3** What is in our Universe?

We will be learning all about Space! We will learn a lot about the planets in our galaxy, black holes, gravity, our moon and more!

We will explore the history of space travel and will show off our knowledge in an informative report. We will also be learning about exceptional people who helped changed space travel forever- people like Katherine Johnson.

## Religion and Worldviews **Unit 4**

In our RW unit this term, Year 6 will be discussing the question: How and why should religious communities do more to care for the Earth?

This unit will enable Y6 to learn in depth about issues of climate change, environmental protection and the future sustainability of the planet, in the light of teaching and practice from different religions.

## Maths

In our lessons, we will divide and multiply by 10, 100, 1000 and 10,000, convert units of measure (e.g 6783m to km) and multiply and divide decimals ( $76.4 \times 23$ ).

We'll recap on shapes and then spend a while on angles.

We will also return to fractions- dividing fractions by integers and finding fractions of amounts.

We will be revising arithmetic and reasoning every day too!
