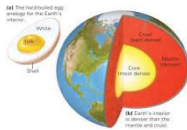


Oak Curriculum - Term 4

We are Geographers: Unit 1

What is our Earth made of?

- Y6 are learning about the layers of the Earth, tectonic plates and what can cause earthquakes.
- Oak class will be getting creative when showing their knowledge and using ICT to research the Ring of Fire.



We are Scientists: Unit 2

How has evolution impacted the wider world?

- We will recognise that living things have changed over time and that fossils provide information about living things that inhabited the Earth millions of years ago.
- We will study inheritance, offspring and adaptation.



We are Artists: Unit 3

How can we review a piece of art?

- Y6 will use their artistic skills to make a collage.
- We will review famous artists' work, focusing on our oracy skills
