

Oak Curriculum - Term 6

We are Scientists:

Unit 1

How has Evolution impacted the natural world?

We will recognise that living things have changed over time and that fossils provide information about living things that inhabited the Earth millions of years ago.

We will study inheritance, offspring and adaptation of all living things.

Using our new knowledge, we will write an explanation about how animals have adapted to their climate in order to survive and reproduce.

We are Designers:

Unit 2

How can I make a frame structure secure?

We will spend a short amount of time discovering how we can make frame structures more secure and which designs allow us to do this. This unit will allow Y6 to learn practically. We will write instructions linked to what we discovered.

We are Artists:

Unit 3

How can we best express ourselves through art?

We will be exploring different ways we can express our identity through drawing, use of colour and design work. Our artist and designer unit will involve some exploration of emotions, creativity with drawings, lines, colour and even tie dye!

English

Now our reading, maths and grammar papers are completed and sent to be marked, our focus is now on writing. Children's writing levels are decided by the class teacher and an external moderator.

We will study a short animation which will prompt some pieces of writing. We will also be writing through our units.

Enterprise & the play.

In July, Y6 will put on a wonderful production. We will be rehearsing as often as we can- practising our scenes and learning the songs. Y6 will need their script in school every day and need to learn their lines (including the songs) at home.

As well as rehearsing, Y6 will have the opportunity to lead their own enterprise project where they work in groups to see if they can design, manufacture and advertise a product. We'll study branding, marketing and how to make a profit.
