Unit

What causes the Earth to shake?

Y6 will learn more about planet Earth and further their learning from their previous geography unit. We will be studying what causes volcanoes, earthquakes and tsunamis and study their features. We will look at the advantages and disadvantages of living on tectonic plate boundaries and use digital mapping to locate hotspots.





How were criminals punished during different periods of history?

A very interesting unit which will look at social history. As Historians we will study the consequences of crime and discuss the similarities, differences and significance of punishment starting in the Roman times through to the Tudors, Middle Ages and continuing past the Victorians era.




How can we best express 3 ourselves?

We will use our knowledge of what causes earthquakes to help us understand how the tsunami was caused but also discuss the impact they can have on people. We will write to persuade as well as a short story with dialogue.
